Education for Democracy

Education for democracy is a complex issue. There are several definitions of "democracy". Highlight what expresses that democracy is the power of the people, of the "demos", but from there a wide range of possibilities opens.

Education for democracy should be based on education in a series of transversal values such as empathy, and the set of human rights.

Explaining and working on concepts about democracy should therefore avoid indoctrination of any kind and, at the same time, make living their values and attitudes to the maximum in specific activities and in classroom life.

We therefore believe that democracy is much more than a doctrine of political action; it is a way and a culture of life



The DEMÀ Association, with the collaboration of several pedagogues and specialists, has produced materials for eight workshops that develop this module: What is democracy for each participant?; Prepare a Constitution I and II; Democratic participation in education; Diversity in Education; Conflicts in education; The role of the Media; The intervention of other agents in education: social networks.

These activities have worked between October and November 2017 in schools participating in the project.
